

# Texas Housing Association Scholarship Application 2010

## Who is Eligible?

- Applicant must be the child of an employee of a PHA in good membership standing.
- Guardianship relationships will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- This scholarship is not for children of commissioners or residents.
- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior.
- Applicant must be a U. S. Citizen.
- Applicant must have demonstrated excellence in the areas of academics, extracurricular school activities and community service.

## How Much is the Scholarship?

Spring 2010, Texas Housing Association (THA) will award three (3) scholarships of \$4000 each. Winners are required to send a copy of their official acceptance letters to THA. Upon receipt, THA will send the funds directly to the applicable Financial Aid office for disbursement.

## What Must be in the Application Package?

### **APPLICATIONS MISSING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE DISQUALIFIED**

1. Letter of introduction from the PHA executive director confirming the applicant's eligibility.
2. Completed application form
3. Essay handwritten by applicant describing his/her future goals and objectives. Minimum of 500 words.
4. Three (3) letters of recommendation from teachers, co-workers, supervisors etc.

5. Certified transcript of grades **INCLUDING FIRST HALF OF SENIOR YEAR** or a letter from the school stating that this information is not yet available to the student.
6. The application asks for size of graduating class, class rank and ACT and/or SAT scores. **THIS INFORMATION MUST BE INCLUDED** or a letter from the school stating that this information is not yet available to the student.
7. Please include a color photo (optional)

### **How are the Applications Rated?**

Applications are rated on a 100 point scale, as follows:

- application form: 10 points maximum
- essay: 10 points maximum
- recommendation letters: 15 points maximum
- grade point average: 35 points maximum
- extracurricular activities and honors: 15 points maximum
- community service: 15 points maximum
